athletic achievements of students by expanding and improving the facilities. During the fiscal year, construction of the \$20 million Thornton Academic Center was opened for student athlete dining and Academic Counseling. The second expansion of Papa John's Cardinal Stadium commenced, with completion expected in the Fall of 2018. ULAA continues to invest in the academic achievement and community involvement of the student-athletes. During the 2016-2017 academic year in the ACC, the Association had 351 student athletes included in the ACC Honor Roll. In addition, seven teams - men's basketball (NABC), women's lacrosse (IWLCA), women's cross country (USTFCCCA), women's track and field (USTFCCCA), field hockey (NFHCA), women's tennis (ITA) and volleyball (AVCA) - were recognized by their national associations for academic achievement Eighteen sports - 10 men's and eight women's - had teams or individuals participating in NCAA postseason competition. That, coupled with 12 programs ending the year in the top 25 in their respective sports, elevated the Cardinal teams to finish 26th in the Learfield Directors' Cup Division I final standing, the highest placement in school history Baseball set a school record for wins, capping the campaign at 53-12 and the program's fourth College World Series appearance. The Cardinals, who finished the year No 5 in every major national poll, won their third-straight ACC Atlantic Division Championship Men's soccer, which finished the year No 6 in the polls, advanced to the NCAA Championship guarterfinal Led by All-American and MAC Hermann Trophy semifinalist Tim Kubel, the team went 14-6-2 and placed second in the ACC Atlantic Division Women's basketball secured a 29-8 overall record, marking the seventh-consecutive season with at least 20 victories. The team earned five victories over AP top-25 opponents and reached the NCAA Sweet 16 for the fifth time in seven years. Football, which won a share of the Atlantic Division regular-season title, rounded out the year ranked in the top 25 for the first time since 2014. The team earned a trip to the Citrus Bowl, the seventh-consecutive season it played in a postseason contest The men's and women's swimming and diving teams, the women's indoor track and field team, and the men's outdoor track and field team each posted top-25 finishes at their respective NCAA Championships. In terms of individual achievements, it was a historical year. Quarterback Lamar Jackson became the youngest winner of the Heisman Trophy - college football's highest honor Pitcher/first baseman Brendan McKay, who is the Cardinals' career strikeout leader and a potent cleanup hitter, was named the Golden Spikes Award winner It is the first time in NCAA history a school has featured both award winners in the same academic year ACC Swimmer of the Year Mallory Comerford tied for the NCAA Championship in the 200 meter freestyle with Olympic champion Katie Ledecky. The 2016 ACC Scholar-Athlete of the Year for Men's Cross Country, Edwin Kibichiy captured the 3,000m steeplechase title at the NCAA Outdoor Championships Louisville enjoyed equal success away from the playing surface. Six University of Louisville athletics teams -- men's and women's basketball, football, men's and women's golf and men's tennis - received NCAA Public Recognition Awards for ranking among the top 10 percent nationally in Academic Progress Rate (APR) scores for the most recent four-year period from 2012-16 Finally. UofL student-athletes amassed over 11,000 service hours through its CardsCARE community outreach program during the 2016-17 year, a total which ranked among the top five in the nation in the NCAA Team Works Challenge


