# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF OPPORTUNITY FUND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

### **ARTICLE I**

The name of this corporation is Opportunity Fund Community Development.

## **ARTICLE II**

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.
- B. The specific and primary purpose of this corporation is to engage in charitable and educational activities within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provisions of any future United States internal revenue law (the "Code"). In furtherance of the foregoing purpose, the specific purposes of the Corporation shall be to perform, participate in and promote community development activities, including, without limitation:
  - 1. Serving, or providing investment capital for, low-income communities or low-income persons;
  - 2. Establishing and building investment funds for the purpose of making loans to and investments in small businesses and nonprofit organizations unable to obtain credit from conventional sources and community facilities serving low-income persons; and
  - 3. Performing outreach activities to assess and evaluate credit needs of the communities to be serviced by the Corporation.

### ARTICLE III

- A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 50l (c)(3) of the Code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 50l(c)(3) of the Code, or (2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Sections 170(c)(2), 2055(a)(2), 2106(a)(2)(A)(ii), 2522(a)(2), or 2522(b)(2) of the Code.
- B. Except as permitted by law, no substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall this corporation participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

#### **ARTICLE IV**

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes, and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member (if any) of this corporation, or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation and after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of this corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to one or more nonprofit funds, foundations, or corporations which are organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and that has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.
