Net assets associated with endowment funds, including funds designated by the board of trustees to function as endowments, are classified and reported based on the existence or ab sence of donor-imposed restrictions. University management, subject to Board ratification, has interpreted the Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds. Act (UPMIFA) as requiring the preservation of the fair value of the original gift as of the gift date of the donor-restricted endowment funds absent explicit donor stipulations to the contrary. As a result of this interpretation, the University classifies as permanently restricted net assets (a) the original value of gifts donated to the permanent endowment, (b) the original value of subsequent gifts to the permanent endowment and (c) accumulations to the permanent endowment made in accordance with the direction of the applicable donor gift instrument at the time the accumulation is added to the fund. The remaining portion of the donor-restricted endowment fund that is not classified in permanently restricted net assets is classified as temporarily restricted net assets until those amounts are appropriated for expenditure by the University in a manner consistent with the standard of prudence prescribed by UPMIFA. In accordance with UPMIFA, the University will consider the following factors in making a determination to appropriate or accumulate donor-restricted endowment funds. (1) The duration and preservation of the fund. (2) The purposes of the organization and the donor-restricted endowment fund. (3) General economic conditions. (4) The possible effect of inflation and deflation. (5) The expected total return from income and the appreciation of investments. (6) Other resources of the organization. (7) The


