CJE SeniorLife's Lieberman Center for Health and Rehabilitation is a skilled nursing care residence (accepting Medicaid, Medicare and Private Pay) offering long-term care, Alzheimer's Special Care Unit, short-term rehabilitation, and hospice/end of life care. In the past year, Lieberman provided person-focused skilled nursing care to more than 600 elderly residents (average age 89) while also providing life enrichment opportunities. Most notable are its award-winning creative art therapies that focus on building personal connections and improving communication skills. Lieberman's Haag Payilion for short-term rehabilitation annually serves 270 individuals recovering from an acute illness, injury or exacerbation of a disease. At an average stay of 4 weeks, Haag Pavilion exceeds the standard for returning patients (with increasing medical complexity due

to their more advanced age) to their prior level of functioning before the illness or injury. Lieberman's payer mix for the year was 70% Medicaid, 15% private pay, 12% Medicare and 3% insurance. Lieberman closely monitors its outcomes through a variety of measures to ensure that it meets or exceeds the regional and national averages of re-hospitalization rates, improved functional abilities, falls data, and house acquired pressure ulcers

CJE SeniorLife offers community-based services to alleviate the difficulties that may arise when someone chooses to "age in place" Primary services include Personal Care, Senior Transportation, Home Delivered Meals, Adult Day Services, and Consumer Assistance with obtaining supportive resources and affordable housing, and solving problems including those related to health insurance. Medicare and Medicaid CJE also provides workshops for community older adults on chronic conditions, maintaining
