ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE ROTARY CLUB OF WATERLOO, IOWA, USA

I, the undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation organized under the provisions of the Revised Iowa Nonprofit Corporation Act, Chapter 504 of the 2009 Code of Iowa, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE 1

The name of this corporation shall be The Rotary Club of Waterloo, Iowa, USA.

ARTICLE II .

This corporation shall be a non-profit corporation. Its purposes shall be charitable and benevolent and to encourage, promote and extend the Object of Rotary, and to maintain the relations of a member club in Rotary International. Insofar as the provisions of the laws of the State of Iowa shall permit, this corporation shall operate in a manner consistent with the constitution and bylaws of Rotary International.

ARTICLEIII

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 531 Commercial Street, Suite 604, Waterloo, Iowa, 50704 and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Kelli McCarthy.

ARTICLE IV

ARTICLE V

The corporation shall have members of a two classes, active and honorary. The characteristics, qualifications, rights, limitations and obligations attaching to each class of members shall be as set out in the bylaws.

ARTICLE VI

Section 1. The affairs and management of this corporation, including the control and distribution of its property and funds, are vested in a Board of Directors which shall be elected according to the bylaws of the corporation. The power to adopt bylaws and amend or alter the same, is vested in its Board of Directors except as otherwise provided by law.

Section 2. This corporation shall have the authority to adopt such bylaws as may be consistent with the purposes enumerated herein and consistent with the law of the State of Iowa.

ARTICLE VII

Section 1. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of activities permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Section 2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Section 3. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, its assets shall be distributed to another Rotary Club, to Rotary International or for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Iowa District Court for Black Hawk County exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operating exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VIII

The members, directors and officers of this corporation and their private property shall not be liable in any manner for corporate debts, obligations. undertakings or liabilities; and the members, directors and officers shall be exempted and indemnified against any personal expenses, losses or liabilities which may accrue from time to time in any manner by reason of the ownership, administration or distribution of the corporate property or funds or by reason of any acts of commission or omission on their part in the conduct of the corporate affairs, so long as they act in good faith. They shall not be liable or accountable in any manner for honest mistakes or errors in judgment, for errors or wrongdoings of agents, brokers, attorneys or servants, nor for interest on funds temporarily idle. They shall have the right at all times and in all matters to act upon any information or evidence deemed by them reliable, without incurring any personal liability or responsibility of any kind or in any manner. No person dealing with the members, directors or officers of the corporation shall be under any obligation to inquire into their power or authority or into the validity, expediency or propriety of their actions, decisions or transactions or to see to the proper application of money or property paid over of transferred to the corporation.

ARTICLE IX

Section 1. The corporation shall, to the extent legally permissible, indemnify each person who may serve or who has served at any time as an officer, director, or employee of the corporation against all expenses and liabilities, including, without limitation, counsel fees, judgments, fines, excise taxes, penalties and settlement payments, reasonably incurred by or imposed upon such person in connection with any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding in which he or she may become involved by reason of his or her service in such capacity; provided that no indemnification shall be provided for any such person with respect to any matter as to which he or she shall have been finally adjudicated in any proceeding not to have acted in good faith in the reasonable belief that such action was in the best interests of the corporation; and further provided that any compromise or settlement payment shall be approved by a majority vote of a quorum of directors who are not at that time parties to the proceeding.

Section 2. The indemnification provided hereunder shall inure to the benefit of the heirs, executors and administrators of persons entitled to indemnification hereunder. The right of indemnification under this Article shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which any person may be entitled.

Section 3. No amendment or repeal of the provisions of this Article which adversely affects the right of an indemnified person under this Article shall apply to such person with respect to those acts or omissions which occurred at any time prior to such amendment or repeal, unless such amendment or repeal was voted by or was made with the written consent of such indemnified person.
