THE ORGANIZATION'S GOVERNING BODY AND MANAGEMENT RELIED ON A LOCAL CPA TO PREPARE THE RETURNS IN A TIMELY MANNER. THERE WAS NO INDICATION BY THE ORIGINALLY ENGAGED CPA THAT HE WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO COMPLETE THE RETURNS. WE RESPECTFULLY REQUEST ABATEMENT OF ANY PENALTIES ASSESSED DUE TO REASONABLE CAUSE.
