## Avera Gettysburg Medical Center:

Part V, Section B, Line 5: Careful consideration was given to ensure input was gathered from persons that represented the broad interests of the community. The hospital engaged the general public to include various ages, health status and income levels, along with local economic development leaders and local business owners. The county health nurse was also interviewed to ensure the hospital included input from those with special knowledge and expertise in public health. Focus groups and key informant interviews were conducted to ensure input gathered would be representative of the community at large. Two focus groups were conducted in March and April, 2016. The Economic Development Committee and the Rotary Committee served as focus groups for the CHNA. These community service groups are already established and represent a good cross-section of the community. These groups include community leaders from ministerial communities, health care, local law enforcement, governance members-representing a voice of the poor and various\_business members of the community.

#### Avera Gettysburg Medical Center:

Part V, Section B, Line 11: Avera Gettysburg Hospital outlined the needs from the most recently completed community health needs assessment in May 2016. The needs identified are new healthcare facility, development of organized wellness programs, and home care/hospice expansion.

Provide a better infrastructure that is conducive to healing for our patients, update technology in serving our patients, and provide more services in the inpatient/outpatient setting. To address this need Avera Gettysburg began working with Avera stakeholders in July 2016 to establish a pro forma and business plan for the potential new facility. Next, Avera Gettysburg established a committee of both Avera and community stakeholders to discuss needs, fund raising and the general direction of the proposed project. The committee will continue working on this project until the need has been met or it is determined to not be feasible.

Development of Organized Wellness Programs

Increase indoor wellness opportunities, decrease adult and child obesity rates and increase physical activity, and create viable options for residents to reach highest health potential. Although the need for this initiative remains high, Avera Gettysburg cannot report any measureable success in the implementation of this endeavor. The main barriers to implementation of this initiative are under staffing and the availability of space in an aging facility.

Home Care/Hospice Expansion

Ensure the community embraces and utilizes the services currently available, expand the geographic service area, and create a sense of local ownership. Although the need for Home Care and Hospice remains in this aging community, Avera Gettysburg is not able to report any enhancements 632098 11-02-18

to these initiatives during the reporting tax year. The main barrier to implementation of this need is staffing. During the reporting year, Avera Gettysburg was reliant on numerous traveling and temporary staff members to fill CNA and RN vacancies in both their Acute and Long Term Care facilities. These vacancies coupled with higher than budgeted patient days during the fiscal year prohibited Avera Gettysburg from dedicating staff to new initiatives.

Other issues that were mentioned in the assessment included: handicap
accessibility, transportation, healthy food choices and work force
development. The hospital works closely with Gettysburg Development
Corporation on work force development issues, and will continue to work on
this. Transportation and handicap accessibility has been studied by
several groups at various times. Avera Gettysburg will continue to work
with these groups to best address the needs of people, especially for
health care transportation issues. It is ever-evolving work. Healthy food
choices will be a natural component/element to the priority of community
wellness program, and the hospital will be involved in that aspect as
appropriate. This may or may not be in this 3-year action plan time.

Avera Gettysburg Medical Center:



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# AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF GETTYSBURG MEDICAL CENTER

PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SDCL CHAPTER 47-22, THE SOUTH DAKOTA SNON-PROFIT CORPORATION ACT, THE UNDERSIGNED CORPORATION ADOPTS THE FOLLOWING AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION. THESE AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION WERE DULY ADOPTED BY THE CORPORATION'S SOLE CORPORATE MEMBER, AVERA ST. MARY'S, A SOUTH DAKOTA NONPROFIT CORPORATION, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER §47-22 OF THE ACT, ON December 12, 2012, to be effective December 31, 2012.

FIRST: The name of the Corporation shall be AVERA GETTYSBURG.

SECOND: The purpose for which this Corporation is formed is and shall be:

- (a) To conduct and maintain charitable, religious and educational institutions;
- (b) To establish, own, operate and maintain a health care facility or facilities for the care of the sick, needy and infirm, and a school, schools, college or colleges for the training of health care professionals;
- (c) To own, operate and maintain a nursing home facility or facilities, home or homes for the aged and congregate care facility or facilities for the care and comfort of elderly residents and senior citizens and such other persons as this Corporation may determine;
- (d) To establish, own, operate and maintain a home health care agency or agencies, a hospice program or programs, an ambulatory surgery facility or facilities, a wellness program or programs, a clinic or clinics, a mental health facility or facilities, a rehabilitation program or programs and any other program or activity that represents a segment of a full continuum of health care;
- (e) To establish, own, operate and maintain a managed care program or programs (including but not limited to, a health maintenance organization, a preferred provider organization, a utilization management company or program and a specialty managed care company or program);
- (f) To establish, own, operate and maintain a third-party administration organization or program;
- (g) To cooperate and affiliate, in any manner, with any insurance company to provide coverages for health care and services;
- (h) To provide management, consulting and administrative services to the health care facilities and programs affiliated with this Corporation, or to those facilities or programs contemplating affiliation with this Corporation;

- (i) To provide guidance, development and administration to health care facilities and programs in the areas of, but not limited to, financial planning and programs, third party reimbursement, research, marketing, personnel, planning, purchasing, and all other services or programs affiliated with or supportive of health;
- (j) To establish, own, operate, maintain and participate in any program to carry out any and all purposes, functions and activities of any and all health and allied programs allowed and/or required pursuant to the laws of the United States and/or the State of South Dakota;
- (k) To confer such degrees, honors or diplomas as are usually conferred and granted by schools and/or colleges, or as shall be appropriate to the course of instruction therein; and in furtherance thereof to do all things necessary, proper and desirable toward such ends and for the promotion of health education, charity, and religion;
- (1) To receive and maintain a fund or funds of real or personal property, or both, and, subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth, to use and apply the whole or any part thereof and to use and apply the whole or any part of the income therefrom and the principal thereof exclusively for charitable, religious, scientific, or educational purposes either directly or by contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended;
- (m) No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office; and
- (n) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this certificate, the Corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended, or by an organization contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of such Code and Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

THIRD: The place where the principal business of this Corporation is to be transacted is the City of Gettysburg, South Dakota, but it may establish and operate branches for charitable, religious and educational purposes at other points in the State. The address of the registered office of this corporation is 610 West 23<sup>rd</sup> Street Suite 1, Yankton, South Dakota 57078. The name of the Corporation's registered agent is Chris Specht.

FOURTH: The term for which this Corporation shall exist shall be perpetual.

FIFTH: The number of the members of the Board of Directors of this Corporation shall not be less than nine (9), and the maximum number of the members of the Board of Directors of this Corporation shall be fixed by the Bylaws.

### SIXTH:

- (a) This Corporation is formed without capital stock and shall have no capital stock.
- (b) No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any Director, officer of the Corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation affecting one or more of its purposes), and no Director, officer of the Corporation, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the Corporation.
- (c) Upon dissolution of the Corporation as directed and approved by the Member, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of Corporation to the Member, or its designee. In the event disposition is to an organization other than the Member, it is the intent that such disposition of assets be to organization(s) organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization(s) under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

SEVENTH: The Member of this Corporation shall be Avera St. Mary's, a nonprofit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Dakota and an organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

EIGHTH: The business affairs of the Corporation shall be conducted by the Board of Directors. The members of the Board of Directors shall be appointed and/or removed by the Member as provided for in the Bylaws. The Board of Directors shall have and exercise all powers which may be exercised or performed by the Corporation under the laws of the State of South Dakota, subject to the powers reserved to the Member of the Corporation as stated in the Bylaws.

Such powers shall be exercised by the Board of Directors and the Member in furtherance of the tax exempt purposes of the Corporation and as may be exercised by an organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended and by an organization contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of such Code and Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

NINTH: The Member of the Corporation shall have power to make, and thereafter to alter or amend, such Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of the Corporation as the Member may deem proper for the management of the affairs of the Corporation, not inconsistent with these Articles, or with the laws of the State of South Dakota relating to and governing corporations not for pecuniary profit, at any annual, regular or special meeting of the Member called for that purpose.

TENTH: The above and foregoing Restated Articles of Incorporation correctly set forth the corresponding provisions of the Articles of Incorporation of Avera Gettysburg as heretofore amended; that the same have been duly adopted as required by the statutes of the State of South Dakota, and that the same supersede the original Articles of Incorporation and all amendments thereto.
