As a mission-driven organization, we provide community benefit because we are committed to our core values of: 1) Service of the Poor - Generosity of spirit, especially for persons most in need, 2) Reverence - Respect and compassion for the dignity and diversity of life, 3) Integrity - Inspiring trust through personal leadership, 4) Wisdom - Integrating excellence and stewardship, 5) Creativity - Courageous innovation, and 6) Dedication - Affirming the hope and joy of our ministry. The primary location of Via Christi Health, Inc. is Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas. The 2016 estimated population was 511,995. Wichita is the largest city within Sedgwick County and the State of Kansas. More than 2,030 patients were helped in fiscal year 2016. 2) Transitional Care Clinic - helps patients transition from the hospital to home or other facility for ongoing care by a multidisciplinary team, which delivers compassionate, personalized care to some of the most vulnerable patients. It was established in 2014 for patients who do not have a primary care provider or cannot be seen by their provider within seven days after being discharged from the hospital. The goal is to ensure a safe and smooth transition and in its first year and a half, it helped reduce inpatient admissions and ER visits by 93 percent.
