alumni, and other charitable activities related to MHS. Additionally, the organization requires grant applications (see Schedule I)
be signed/approved by MHS's Principal and applicable school department chairperson, as well as be approved by a majority of the
organization's board of directors. Grant recipients are required to submit a Grant Follow-Up Report (see attachment to Schedule I) detailing
the utilization and outcome that resulted from the matter supported by the grant. The principal of MHS regularly attends the organization's
board meetings and provides a report as to pertinent school-related matters. Thus, the supported organization has an adequate relationship
