How to Apply:

Once you have reviewed the tutorial, you will be ready to click on the Live link.

If this is your first time submitting a grant to the Foundation, you will need to create a user id and password, before submitting a Letter of Inquiry (LOI) to the Foundation. If you have submitted and received grants in the past from the Foundation, please contact Barbara Marter at wosborne@comcast.net for your user id and password.

We will review your LOI and if your inquiry fits within the guidelines set down by our Trustees, you will be sent an email notifying you to continue on to the next stage and complete the full proposal. It is important that you remember your user id and password for future grant submissions or to check on the status of a request. We will also be happy to reset your password for you.

Grants are not generally funded for:

- Individuals
- Debt Reduction
- Political Causes
- For Profit organizations
- Grantees outside the Greater Chattanooga Area

Interim Report:

If your request is for the Foundation to fund a grant over more than one year, interim reports will be required not less often than annually before consideration of funding for later years. Grantees must agree to refund any unused portion of a grant that is not used for the stated purpose or purposes. No grant funds may be redirected to another project without the written consent of the Foundation.
