The Board of Trustees may remove at any time, with or without cause, any member of the Compensation Committee, provided the filing organization's members, Portercare Adventist Health System (PAHS) and Catholic Health Initiatives Colorado (CHIC), shall have exclusive authority to appoint or remove, with or without cause, any member it or they appoint to the Compensation Committee. The consultant's recommendations are presented to and deliberated by the Compensation Committee. The Compensation Committee relies upon all available comparable compensation data in finalizing its decision concerning compensation for its senior executive positions. The Compensation Committee deliberations and decisions are documented appropriately. The filing organization's Human Resources department performs an annual analysis of the market to determine compensation ranges for the remainder of the filing organization's Executives which are reviewed and approved by the filing organization's senior leadership.
