BRIEF PROFILE OF THE FOUNDERS

The Jerome and Dorothy Holz Family Foundation was established on December 31, 1996; by the Jerome J. Holz family to benefit various educational programs, specified school curriculums, and community activities and projects in the Greater Milwaukee Area.

The Jerome and Dorothy Holz family started in May 1949 when Jerry and Dorothy Schübring, who grew up together in Hales Corners, started their married life together which union grew into a beautiful love story and parenthood to their two daughters, Judy Holz-Stathas and Barbara Holz-Weis.
