Any new indirect benefit plan requires approval by the Boston Children's He art Foundation, Inc 's (the Foundation's) Board of Directors, which then must be reviewed and permitted by the Hospital. Major procedures of the approval process involve comparing compensation data of physicians within the comparable field of medicine, indirect compens ation currently being offered, and the financial stability of the Foundation.
