RIHF's largest permanently restricted endowment generates income which is donor-designated, to support critical components necessary to create a collaborative and synergistic environment to better treat and unravel the mysteries of the brain and nervous system via a groundbreaking Neurosciences Institute at RIH. RIHF maintain sanother large permanently restricted endowment fund, the income from which defrays the cost of charity care provided by RIH. Income from RIHF's other notable permanently restricted endowments supports. (1)nursing education, (2)HCH's Child Protection Program in its provision of services to abused and neglected children, and (3) pediatric asthma and allergy care. The largest temporarily restricted funds held by RIHF are used to support pediatric care and Brain Science Research at RIH, including support of the Brain Tissue Resource. Center and the Norman Prince Neurosciences Institute. RIHF's unrestricted endowment is used for various needs of RIH and to partially defray fundraising expenses.
