

If MMC AA ceases to exist or no longer performs its functions under the provisions of the agreement, the Midland County Community Foundation shall continue to administer and disburse fund assets in a manner deemed appropriate. Investment and spending policies are determined by the Midland County Community Foundation, in accordance with established guidelines adopted by the Foundation's governing board.


