THE FOUNDATION RECENTLY LAUNCHED A WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE PURSUANT TO WHICH IT MAKE CONTRIBUTIONS TO CERTAIN QUALIFYING ORGANIZATIONS IN SUPPORT OF THEIR WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS.
