



Vidant Roanoke-Chowan Hospital, Vidant Edgecombe Hospital, Vidant Chowan Hospital, Vidant Bertie Hospital, Vidant Duplin Hospital, Vidant Beaufort Hospital, and The Outer Banks Hospital VMC serves as the teaching hospital for the Brody School of Medicine, East Carolina Schools of Nursing and Allied Health and Pitt Community College. The system also services as a regional referral center for eastern North Carolina. The System's eight hospitals are licensed to operate 1,439 beds. Each hospital is licensed by the Division of Facility Services of the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services and approved as a provider by the Medicare and Medicaid programs. VH and its hos pitals and affiliate organizations provide services to patients without regard to their ability to pay. In fiscal year 2017 VH's combined patient care statistics were inpatient ad missions, 63,382, inpatient days of care, 339,393, surgeries, 46,558, births, 5,710, and o utpatient visits, 332,795.
