Equipped with basic supplies like paper and pencils, laptops, printers, databases and the latest technologies, Homework Centers offer educational games, software and tools and are stocked with healthy snacks to feed bodies and minds. Adults without high school diplomas make less than their peers who graduated high school, for many a diploma is the difference between poverty and a living wage. By providing healthy meals and snacks the library was able to remove one of the largest barriers that keeps children from learning and growing over the summer and play a larger role in helping children enter the next school year ready to learn!
