IT SHALL ALSO BE LIMITED TO CHARITABLE PURPOSES WHICH SHALL INCLUDE ONLY RELIGIOUS, CHARITABLE, SCIENTIFIC, LITERARY, OR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES WITHIN THE MEANING OF IRC SECTION 501 (C) (3).
