Part I, Line 2, Monitoring Procedures:

We make monetary and food grants to those residents who meet our income eligibility standards. Applicants complete a paper application, which is reviewed by the Executive Director who

then holds an interview and records the results on the application. All paper applications are kept on file for a minimum of three years.

Utility, fuel, rent and other assistance are all paid by check on the applicant's behalf to local creditors. Food assistance is of perishable, non-perishable and frozen foods that are given

directly to the applicant. We maintain supermarket style food shelves from which we distribute the food. We measure the value of food distributions with reference to retail food prices in

southeastern Vermont markets.

All assistance is logged on a digital spreadsheet to show the number of recipients and the dollar value of assistance, and is kept with the paper applications for at least three years.

All funds are distributed from a checking account maintained by the Executive Director and the Treasurer. A summary of grants distributed is given to each director monthly and is

printed in the annual town reports for each town that we serve.
