The board or committee shall determine whether the Center can obtain a more advantageous transaction or arrangement from a person or 3. If a more advantageous transaction or arrangement is not reasonably obtainable, the board or committee shall determine by a majority vote of the disinterested board or committee members whether the proposed transaction or arrangement is in the best interest of the Center and if the Center should enter into the proposed transaction or arrangement.
