The fifth program, the annual choice of a Barton L. Weller scholar, who must be a student in one of the five high schools, is chosen according to the rules and regulations established by the Foundation, which are described in the attached brochure regarding the program.

The seventh program, The Weller Instrumental Music Scholarship, is presented annually to high school students who have enrolled in a conservatory or college as a music major with a concentration in instrumental music. There was no program in 2017.

The eighth program, the Weller Medical/Health Sciences Scholarship, is presented annually based on the rules and regulations as described in the attached summary of the program.

The ninth program, the Weller Education Scholarship, is presented annually to a high school senior planning to pursue a teaching career in public or private elementary or secondary schools. The recipient is chosen according to the rules described in the attached summary.

The tenth program, the Weller Computer Science/Technology Scholarship, is presented annually to a high school senior planning to pursue a career in computer science or computer engineering. There was no program in 2017.
