General Explanation

Explanation:

The Joyce and Irving Goldman Foundation (the "Foundation") has recently amended its Form 990-PF for the tax years ended December 31, 2014, 2015 and 2016 to correct its Minimum Investment Return calculation in Part X and to re-calculate its undistributed income reported in Part XI due to the incorrect valuation of certain prior year non-charitable use assets. The returns were also revised to include certain realized capital gains that were omitted from the originally filed returns in addition to certain other minor adjustments.

The Foundation will be filing Form 4720 for all affected years, including 2017. In accordance with Internal Revenue Code section 4962(a), since the prior inaccuracies described above were due to reasonable cause and not due to willful neglect, the Foundation will be seeking abatement of the excise tax shown thereon. In addition the Foundation has conservatively estimated and will pay an amount above and beyond what it believes would be the revised minimum distribution requirement in calendar 2018 to account for the prior year deficiencies resulting from the incorrect valuation of assets.
