receipt form that is to be signed by the person that the shipment was addressed to or their representative. The acknowledgement of receipt
specifies what product has been sent, brand name, manufacturer, lot number, quantity of the product and expiry date. In addition to this we
ask the recipient countries to provide a detailed utilization report.
