Over the course of 2017, America's Agenda Health Care for All (AAHCA) program services continued to promote and expand delivery of higher quality patient care, while achieving more affordable overall health costs and a substantially improved patient experience. AAHCA programs put principal emphasis on transformation to advanced primary care design for two principal reasons a) because robust provision of well-designed, broad scope primary care is the most cost effective means of preventing and cost-effectively managing chronic disease which accounts for 84% of overall health care spending in the US and b) scaling of well-designed, broad scope primary care offers significant leverage toward high-value transformation of secondary and tertiary health care delivery where, in the US today, most health care dollars are spent. In 2017, AAHCA added a new priority emphasis in our ongoing work improved affordability of prescription medications. This is because the cost of prescription medications has become the most rapidly growing component of overall health costs. Attainment of the AAHCA mission of securing affordable health care for every American requires a solution to growth in cost of pharmaceutical medicines that currently outpaces significantly not only US wages and GDP, but also the rate of growth in overall health costs AAHCAs updated program services, described below in more detail with key accomplishments, are 1 Campaign to transform delivery of health care for New Jersey public employees focusing on advocacy for high-value primary care design and acceleration of its growth 2 Campaign to implement modernized, cost-saving acquisition of prescription medicines, reigning in the fastest growing portion of overall health care spending, without reducing health coverage or benefits for working Americans 3 Call to Action to Self-funded Employer Health Plans to Lead in Transformation of America's Health Care (a campaign aimed at accelerating regional and industry-wide high-value care delivery transformation through leadership of self-funded health plans) Detailed Program Activities 1 In 2017, America's Agenda Health Care for All ("AAHCA") built upon our success in the previous year in achieving adoption of a program to offer access for approximately 800,000 New Jersey public employees, dependents, and retirees to high-value direct primary care that offers an expanded scope of primary care services with no out-of-pocket cost-sharing and individualized patient care and overall care coordination by personal and family physicians. As the pilot program is scaled, it is designed to demonstrate that a robust primary care delivery system that reduces or eliminates barriers to access will substantially reduce overall health care costs. We consider this statewide New Jersey pilot program to be a demonstration of the productivity that a high value care delivery program can have in other states, as well, in relieving pressure o taxpavers by savings hundreds of millions of dollars in State employee health care spending. Moreover, as the program scales, we intend to demonstrate that the high-value care delivery design actually reduces costs by engaging and supporting employees and dependent families in healthy behavioral changes that improve their health outcomes. The pilot program is designed to create networks of advanced, high-value, direct primary care health centers in communities where high densities of public employees live and work. It aims to allow private sector employers and employees to access the direct primary care medical homes established initially to serve public employees, thereby dispersing the benefits of higher value care across entire New Jersey communities. However, the first implementation threshold that must be met for the program to succeed is growth in public employee and dependent enrollment. During the course of 2017, AAHCA has placed a major priority on conducting a coordinated campaign to build enrollment in the State of New Jerseys Direct Primary Care Medical Home Pilot Program (DPCMH) There have been significant challenges to contacting and educating eligible enrollees about the program AAHCA worked extensively to support a coordinated campaign by public employee representatives to overcome those obstacles Approximately 2,500 eligible employees and family members have enrolled over the course of 2017. We are encouraged by our success in enrolling these public employee family members and by the very high rate of satisfaction they have expressed with their new health care experience. Yet looking ahead, we will need to accelerate the rate of enrollment growth in the DPCMH program to achieve the DPCMH program objectives 2. Over the course of the preceding year, 2016, AAHCA achieved major advances in our campaign to win consensus among New Jersey State legislators, the Governor, and public employee representatives to create a more dynamically competitive marketplace for selecting Pharmacy Benefit Managers that administer a \$1 billion per year spend on prescription medications for New Jersey public employee families Ultimately, we achieved agreement among the New Jersey Governor, legislative leaders, and public employee representatives to implement the Americas Agenda designed strategy to reduce prescription drug costs in lieu of making draconian cuts in public employee health care benefits. By years end, legislation was enacted that would allow expedited State contracting of technology that met AAHCAproposed guidelines for creating dynamic PBM competition for the States prescription pharmacy account (See AAHCA work cited in http://www.nispotlight.com/stories/16/11/03/sweeney-plan-could-save-200m-in-prescription-costs-for-public-workers/ http://www.njspotlight.com/stories/16/12/01/state-seeks-high-tech-oversight-of-2b-annual-spending-on-drug-benefits/, and http://senatorsweeney.com/cost-saving-billprescription-drugs-goes-governor/During the first half of 2017, AAHCA provided strategic advice to key State leaders in the Administration, State legislature, and public employee representatives who were involved in implementing the AAHCA strategy. The proposed reverse auction for PBM plans was carried out. The result was net savings to State taxpayers projected at \$1 6 billion over the next 3 years of a radically transformed PBM contract. This sayings success was so substantial that it contributed significantly to the budget agreement enabling reopening of the New Jersey State Government, which had shut down over failure of the Governor and State legislature to reach a budget agreement. The success of AAHCAs New Jersey prescription drug sayings initiative was particularly significant as a model for adoption byother states. The principal result of the AAHCA initiative was an 18% reduction in the cost of pharmaceutical medicines without cutting pharmacy benefits for public worker families, at all. As health care costs rose at an accelerating rate for health plans beneficiaries across America in 2017, the health plan premiums for State employees, retirees, and dependents remained flat no premium increase, at all -- as a result of the success of the AAHCA campaign 3 AAHCA views the sponsors and trustees of self-funded, employment-based health plans that provide health care to 1/3 of all Americans as key strategic partners in our campaign to achieve high-value transformation of American health care. Selffunded health plan sponsors have unparalleled flexibility to adopt care delivery innovations that can reduce healthcare costs, improve care quality, and expand access to high-value health care, not only to their own participants, but across their local communities and regions. Bolstered by 2016 reports of impressive savings results achieved in AAHCAs private sector initiatives (i.e. in the packinghouse and building services industries) and the expansion of the NJ Direct Primary Care Medical Home Pilot Program. AAHCA brought our Call to Action campaign to Self-funded Employer Health Plans into new public sector jurisdictions and private sector industries over the course of 2017 In the public sector, for example, AAHCA advocated for innovative care delivery re-design to public school board members and education union representatives in multiple school districts across the State of Maryland AAHCA, along with our New Jersey Education Association partner organization, took our Call to Action to the Health Care Commission of the State of Delaware as invited panelists and presenters. As a private sector example, AAHCA has held extensive discussion with General Motors, UAW, and their joint Labor-Management Committee, analyzing aggregated health care claims and other relevant data in the process, over the course of 2017 with the objective of launching several pilot health centers that would implement AAHCA Call to Action high-value design principles for union-represented GM workers Our contention is that highvalue rede


