



BYLAWS

OF

THE HAMLIN FAMILY FOUNDATION INC.

(a Delaware charitable nonprofit nonstock corporation)

ARTICLE I

Offices

Section 1.01 Location The principal office of The Hamlin Family Foundation Inc. (the "Corporation") within or without the State of Delaware shall be located at such place as the Board of Directors shall from time to time designate. The Corporation may maintain additional offices at such other places as the Board of Directors may designate The Corporation shall have and maintain within the State of Delaware a registered office at such place as may be designated by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE II

Purposes

Section 2.01 *Purposes* The Corporation shall not donate to any organizations (a) that receive significant financial support (more than 25%) from a government or government agency, whether domestic or foreign, or (b) that do not support (i) limited government, (ii) personal responsibility, (iii) free market capitalism, or (iv) individual and political liberty or originalist American constitutional principles. These purposes can only be amended by a unanimous vote of the surviving Hamlin Family Members, as defined in Section 3.01 of these Bylaws.

Section 2.02 Existence. The Corporation shall terminate on the later of (i) January 1, 2060, or (ii) ten years after the death of the last Hamlin Family Member, as defined in Section 3 01 of these Bylaws. All assets shall be distributed in accordance with Section 2.01 prior to that date. In the event that assets remain in the Corporation on that date, such assets shall be distributed according to Article EIGHTH of the Corporation's Certificate of Incorporation as amended and restated and consistent with Section 2.01 of these Bylaws.

ARTICLE III

Members

Section 3.01 Members. Clay Hamlin and Lynn Hamlin shall be the initial members of the Corporation (the "Initial Members") The Initial Members may appoint additional individuals to serve as members (together with the Initial Members, the "Members"), provided that there shall never be more than five Members. The Members may designate one or more successor Members by executing a consent designating such successors and the conditions for their appointment and such appointment may be effective immediately or upon the occurrence of

some future event. Clay and Lynn Hamlin and their children shall be considered the "Hamlin Family Members"

The membership structure is intended to preserve family control of the Corporation, and in the event that there is a dispute regarding the interpretation of any provision of these bylaws, continued family control should be the guiding interpretive principle.

Upon the resignation, death, or incapacity of all of the Members: (i) if the Members (including by action of the executor, administrator or legal representative of a deceased Member) have designated successor members in the event of the resignation, death or incapacity of all of the Members, such designated persons shall become Members; (ii) if the Members did not designate successor Members, the individuals serving on the Board of Directors shall serve as the Members, (iii) if the Members have not designated successor Members and the Corporation does not have at least one director, then the Corporation shall dissolve and, in accordance with the terms of Article EIGHTH of the Corporation's Certificate of Incorporation, all of the Corporation's assets shall be distributed to those public charities and in such proportions as designated as the Corporation's default charities on the Corporation's "Default Charity List" maintained on the Administrator's website, less all costs and expenses related thereto, and further, the Administrator shall be authorized to take any and all necessary actions that may be required under applicable law and the Certificate of Incorporation to effect such dissolution.

The Members shall have such rights, privileges and obligations of members conferred upon them by the Certificate of Incorporation and these Bylaws, and otherwise accorded by the Delaware General Corporation Law. For all purposes under these Bylaws, a Member's incapacity shall be established by the written statement of that Member's personal physician that the individual is no longer able to manage his or her own affairs.

Section 3 02 Annual Meetings. Unless directors are elected by written consent of Members in lieu of a meeting, an annual meeting of Members for the election of directors or the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the meeting shall be held at such time and place as the Members shall determine.

Section 3.03 Special Meetings. Special meetings of the Members may be called by the Board of Directors or by a majority of the Members.

Section 3 04 Notice of Meetings and Waiver of Notice. Written notice of all meetings of Members shall be given not less than 10 nor more than 60 days before the date of the meeting to each Member entitled to vote at such meeting. The notices of all meetings shall state the place, if any, date and hour of the meeting, the means of remote communications, if any, by which Members and proxy holders may be deemed to be present in person and vote at such meeting and, in the case of a special meeting, the purpose or purposes for which the meeting is called Any notice shall be effective if given by a form of electronic transmission consented to by the Member to whom the notice is given Notice of any meeting need not be given to any Member who shall, either before or after the meeting, submit a waiver of notice or who shall attend such meeting, except when the Member attends for the express purpose of objecting, at the beginning of the meeting, to the transaction of any business because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened.

Section 3.05 *Quorum*. Except as otherwise provided by law or the Certificate of Incorporation, a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of Members shall consist of a majority of the Members then serving and entitled to vote at the meeting, present in person or by proxy.

Section 3.06 Election of Directors and Voting. Members shall elect the directors Directors shall be elected at every third consecutive regular annual meeting of the Members (each such third annual meeting an "Election Meeting"). If the election of the directors shall not be held at such a meeting, such election shall be held as soon thereafter as is conveniently possible. At all such elections of directors the voting may, but need not, be by ballot and a plurality of the votes of the Members present in person or by proxy at the meeting and entitled to vote on the election of directors shall be sufficient to elect directors. Except as otherwise provided by law, the Certificate of Incorporation or these Bylaws, any other action shall be authorized by the vote of the majority of the Members present in person or by proxy at the meeting and entitled to vote on the subject matter

Section 3.07 Action by Written Consent. Member action may be taken without a meeting if the Members consent thereto in writing (including by electronic transmission). and the writing or writings are filed with the records of the Corporation, except as otherwise provided by law, the certificate of incorporation or these Bylaws.

Section 3.08 Actions Requiring Member Approval. The following actions require the prior approval by a majority of all of the Members: (i) amending the Certificate of Incorporation. (ii) amending or repealing the Bylaws: (iii) adopting an agreement of merger or consolidation; (iv) adopting a plan of wind-up and dissolution; (v) the sale, lease, transfer or other disposition of all or any substantial part of the Corporation's assets or properties; and (vi) the creation of a subsidiary or another related organization.

ARTICLE IV

Board of Directors

- Section 4.01 Power of Board of Directors and Qualification of Directors. The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by or under the direction of the Board of Directors. Each director shall be at least eighteen years of age
- Section 4.02 *Number of Directors*. The number of directors constituting the entire Board of Directors shall not be less than one (1) nor more than ten (10).
- Section 4.03 *Election and Term of Directors*. Directors shall be elected at every Election Meeting of the Members. Each director shall hold office for a term ending no later than the date of the next Election Meeting and until his or her successor has been elected and qualified or until his or her death or until he or she shall resign or be removed.
- Section 4.04 Newly-Created Directorships and Vacancies. Newly created directorships resulting from an increase in the number of directors elected may be filled by action of the Members. Vacancies occurring in the Board of Directors for any reason may be filled by vote of a majority of the Members. A director elected to fill a vacancy shall hold office until the next Election Meeting and until his or her successor shall have been elected and qualified.

A person may accept his or her directorship election by accessing the Administrator's system at the website designated in Section 6.08 hereof or as otherwise designated by the Administrator and complying with such directions as may be posted therein or otherwise provided by the Administrator. The election of a person to fill a newly-created directorship or a vacancy shall be effective only in the event that such person has accepted his or her election, in the manner described in the immediately preceding sentence, within the 60-day period commencing on the date that notice of such election has been sent to such person via electronic means or otherwise.

Section 4.05 Resignation Any director may resign from office at any time by delivering (i) a resignation in writing to the Board of Directors or to the President of the Corporation and (ii) a copy of such resignation to the Administrator by accessing the Administrator's system at the website designated in Section 6.08 hereof or as otherwise designated by the Administrator and complying with such directions as may be posted therein or otherwise provided by the Administrator. Such resignation shall take effect at the time specified therein, and unless otherwise specified, no acceptance of such resignation shall be necessary to make it effective.

Section 4.06 Removal of Directors. Any one or more of the directors may be removed with or without cause at any time by vote of a majority of the Board of Directors or by action of the Members, provided that written notice of such removal is given to any director so removed and a copy of such notice is delivered to the Administrator by accessing the Administrator's system at the website designated in Section 6.08 hereof or as otherwise designated by the Administrator and complying with such directions as may be posted therein or otherwise provided by the Administrator.

Section 4.07 Meetings of the Board of Directors. An annual meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held each year at such time and place as may be fixed by the President for the transaction of such business as may properly come before the meeting, and, in the case of an Election Meeting, for the election of officers and directors. Regular meetings of the Board of Directors may be held at such times as may be fixed by the President. Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called by or at the direction of the President or by a majority of the directors in office.

Written, oral, or any other mode of notice of the time and place shall be given for regular and special meetings to both directors and Members in sufficient time for the convenient assembly of the directors thereat. In any event, notice of any regular or special meeting shall be given to the Administrator by accessing the Administrator's system at the website designated in Section 6.08 hereof or as otherwise designated by the Administrator and complying with such directions as may be posted therein or otherwise provided by the Administrator. Notice need not be given to any director who submits a written waiver of notice signed by him or her before or after the time stated therein. Attendance of any such person at a meeting shall constitute a waiver of notice of such meeting, except when he or she attends a meeting for the express purpose of objecting, at the beginning of the meeting, to the transaction of any business because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened. Neither the business to be transacted at, nor the purpose of, any regular or special meeting of the directors need be specified in any written waiver or notice.

A majority of the directors present, whether or not a quorum is present, may adjourn any meeting to another time and place. Notice of any adjournment of a meeting of the Board of Directors to another time or place shall be given (i) to the Administrator by accessing the Administrator's system at the website designated in Section 6.08 hereof or as otherwise designated by the Administrator and complying with such directions as may be posted therein or otherwise provided by the Administrator, and (ii) in the manner described above to the directors who were not present at the time of the adjournment and, unless such time and place are announced at the meeting, to other directors.

The President, if present and acting, shall preside at all meetings. Otherwise, any other director chosen by the Board of Directors shall preside.

Section 4.08 Quorum and Voting. Unless a greater proportion is required by law, by the Certificate of Incorporation, or by these Bylaws adopted by a unanimous vote of the Board of Directors, a majority of the entire Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business or of a specified item of business Except as otherwise provided by law by the Certificate of Incorporation or by these Bylaws, the vote of a majority of the entire Board of Directors, shall be the act of the Board of Directors.

Section 4 09 Written Consent of Directors, Meeting by Conference Telephone or by Comparable Medium Any action required or permitted to be taken by the Board of Directors may be taken without a meeting if all members of the Board of Directors consent thereto in writing Each consent so adopted by members of the Board of Directors shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the Board of Directors and a copy of each such consent shall be printed and delivered to the Administrator by accessing the Administrator's system at the website designated in Section 6 08 hereof or as otherwise designated by the Administrator and complying with such directions as may be posted therein or otherwise provided by the Administrator.

To the extent permitted by law, any one or more members of the Board of Directors may participate in a meeting of the Board of Directors by means of a conference telephone, Internet chat room or similar communications equipment allowing all persons participating in the meeting to hear or to otherwise communicate with each other at the same time Participation by such means shall constitute presence in person at a meeting

Section 4.10 Compensation of Directors. Directors shall not receive any stated salaries for their services, provided that nothing herein contained shall be construed to preclude any director from serving the Corporation in any other legally permitted capacity and receiving reasonable compensation therefor. At all times, such compensation shall not exceed what is ordinarily considered to be reasonable compensation for services rendered. In no event shall an item of compensation be paid if such compensation shall constitute an "excess benefit" within the meaning of Section 4958 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code").

Section 4.11 *Records*. Minutes shall be kept of each meeting of the Board of Directors Copies of the minutes of each meeting shall be filed with the corporate records of the Corporation and a copy of such minutes shall be delivered to the Administrator by accessing the Administrator's system at the website designated in Section 6.08 hereof or as otherwise

designated by the Administrator and complying with such directions as may be posted therein or otherwise provided by the Administrator

ARTICLE V

Officers, Agents and Employees

Section 5.01 *General Provisions*. The Board of Directors shall elect the officers of the Corporation The officers of the Corporation shall be one (1) President, one (1) Treasurer, one (1) Secretary and may consist of an unlimited number of Vice-Presidents. The Board of Directors may give any of them further designation or alternate titles as it considers desirable.

Section 5 02 Term of Office. Each officer shall serve for a term of one year following his or her election or appointment and until such time as his or her respective successor is elected and qualified or until his or her earlier death, resignation or removal. Any vacancy in any office arising from any cause may be filled for the unexpired portion of the term by the Board of Directors.

Section 5 03 Resignation and Removal. Any officer may resign at any time upon written notice to the Corporation. Any officer may be removed from office, with or without cause, at any time by the Board of Directors.

Section 5.04 *Power and Duties of Officers*. Subject to the control of the Board of Directors, all officers as between themselves and the Corporation shall have such authority and perform such duties in the management of the property and affairs of the Corporation as may be provided in these Bylaws and, to the extent not so provided, as generally pertain to their respective offices

A President. The President shall have general management and supervision of the property, business and affairs of the Corporation and over its other officers; may appoint and remove assistant officers and other agents and employees, other than officers referred to in this Article, and may execute and deliver in the name of the Corporation powers of attorney, contracts, and other obligations and instruments.

The President of the Corporation, officers designated by the President, and committees designated by the President that are composed exclusively of members of the Board of Directors, shall have the power and authority to approve, make and cause to be made charitable contributions by the Corporation. All charitable contributions approved by any of the foregoing (each a "Grant Evaluator"), shall for all purposes be, and be deemed to be, duly authorized by the Board of Directors and the Corporation. The President or the Board of Directors may at any time appoint or remove an individual or committee as a Grant Evaluator provided that such appointment or removal shall not be effective unless and until notice thereof is provided to the Administrator in the manner specified by it.

B Vice-President. A Vice-President may execute and deliver in the name of the Corporation contracts and other obligations and instruments pertaining to the regular course of the duties of said office, and shall have such other authority as

from time to time may be assigned by the Board of Directors or the President. One Vice-President shall be designated by the Board of Directors to perform the duties and exercise the powers of the President in the event of the President's absence or disability.

- C Treasurer. The Treasurer shall prepare financial statements and supervise the Corporation's cash, investments, assets and liabilities and such other duties as directed by the Board of Directors. The Treasurer shall report to the President, the Board of Directors and Members from time to time.
- D. Secretary. The Secretary shall prepare or supervise the preparation of the minutes of the meetings of the Board of Directors and the Members; have custody of the books, records, and documents (other than those maintained by the Treasurer); and attest deeds. contracts, leases and other legal instruments and formal documents; and shall perform such other duties as may be assigned by the Board of Directors or the President.

Section 5.05 Agents and Employees. The Board of Directors may appoint agents and employees who shall have such authority and perform such duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors may remove any agent or employee at any time with or without cause. Removal without cause shall be without prejudice to such person's contract rights, if any, and the appointment of such person shall not itself create contract rights.

Section 5.06 Compensation of Officers. Agents and Employees. The Corporation may pay compensation in reasonable amounts to agents and employees for services rendered to the Corporation, such amount to be fixed by the Board of Directors, or, if the Board of Directors delegates power to any officer or officers, then by such officer or officers. The Board of Directors may require officers, agents or employees to give security for the faithful performance of their duties.

ARTICLE VI

Miscellaneous

- Section 6.01 Fiscal Year. The fiscal year of the Corporation shall be the calendar year.
- Section 6.02 *Corporate Seal*. The seal of the Corporation shall be circular in form and contain the name of the Corporation, the words "Corporate Seal" and "Delaware" and the year the Corporation was formed in the center. The Corporation may use the seal by causing it or a facsimile thereof to be affixed or impressed or reproduced in any manner.
- Section 6 03 Checks, Notes, Contracts. The President shall determine who shall be authorized from time to time on the Corporation's behalf to sign checks, notes, drafts, acceptances, bills of exchange and other orders or obligations for the payment of money; to enter into contracts, or to execute and deliver other documents and instruments.
- Section 6.04 Books and Records. The Corporation shall keep at its office or at any other designated office (1) correct and complete books and records of accounts, (2) minutes of the proceedings of its Board of Directors, and (3) a current list or record containing the names and

addresses of all directors and officers of the Corporation Any of the books, records and minutes of the Corporation may be in written form or in any other form capable of being converted into written form within a reasonable time.

Section 6.05 Amendments of Bylaws. Except as otherwise provided in the certificate of incorporation or these Bylaws, these Bylaws may be amended or repealed, and new Bylaws may be adopted by a majority of the Members entitled to vote in the election of directors. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no amendment, alteration, change or repeal of these Bylaws shall be effected which will result in the denial of tax-exempt status to the Corporation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

Section 6 06 Indemnification and Insurance. The Corporation shall indemnify any director, officer, employee or agent, any former director, officer, employee or agent, any person who may have served at its request as a director, officer, employee or agent of another corporation of any type or kind, domestic or foreign, or any partnership, joint venture, trust, or other enterprise, whether for profit or not for profit, against expenses (including attorney's fees), judgments, fines and amounts paid in settlement, actually and reasonably incurred by him or her in connection with any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding whether civil, criminal, administrative, or investigative (other than an action by or in the right of the Corporation), to which he or she may be or is made a party by reason of being or having been such director, officer, employee or agent if he or she acted in good faith and in a manner he or she reasonably believed to be in or not opposed to the best interests of the Corporation and, with respect to any criminal action or proceeding, had no reasonable cause to believe his or her conduct was unlawful. However, there shall be no indemnification in respect of any claim, issue or matter as to which he or she shall have been adjudged to be liable to the Corporation unless and only to the extent that the court in which such action or suit was brought shall determine upon application that, despite the adjudication of liability, but in view of all the circumstances of the case, such person is fairly and reasonably entitled to be indemnified for such expenses which the court shall deem proper.

The Corporation may pay expenses (including attorneys' fees) incurred by an officer or director in defending any civil. criminal, administrative or investigative action, suit or proceeding in advance of the final disposition of such action, suit or proceeding upon receipt of an undertaking by or on behalf of such officer or director, to repay such amount if it shall ultimately be determined that he or she is not entitled to be indemnified by the Corporation under this Article Such expenses (including attorneys' fees) incurred by other employees and agents may be paid upon such terms and conditions, if any, as the Board of Directors deems appropriate. The Corporation shall have the power to purchase and maintain insurance to indemnify the Corporation and its directors and officers to the full extent such indemnification is permitted by law

Any indemnification (unless ordered by a court) shall be made by the Corporation only as authorized in the specific case upon a determination that indemnification of the director, officer, employee or agent is proper in the circumstances because he or she has met the applicable standard of conduct set forth in title 8, section 145(a) and (b) of the Delaware General Corporation Law. Such determination shall be made (1) by a majority vote of the directors who are not parties to such action, suit or proceeding, even though less than a quorum, or (2) if there

are no such directors or if such directors so direct, by independent legal counsel in a written opinion.

The provisions of this Article shall be applicable to claims, actions, suits, or proceedings made or commenced after the adoption hereof, whether arising from acts or omissions occurring before or after adoption hereof.

The indemnification or advancement of expenses provided by this Article shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which such director, officer, employee or agent may be entitled under any statute, Bylaw, agreement, vote of the disinterested directors or otherwise, and shall not restrict the power of the Corporation to make any indemnification permitted by law.

The indemnification or advancement of expenses provided by this Article shall, unless otherwise provided when authorized or ratified, continue as to a person who has ceased to be a director, officer, employee or agent and shall inure to the benefit of the heirs, executors and administrators of such person.

The Board of Directors may authorize the purchase of insurance on behalf of any person who is or was a director, officer, employee or agent of the Corporation, or who is or was serving at the request of the Corporation as a director, officer, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise against any liability asserted against or incurred by him or her in any such capacity, or which arises out of such person's status as a director, officer, employee or agent whether or not the Corporation would have the power to indemnify such person against that liability under law

Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the Corporation shall not indemnify, reimburse, or insure any person for any taxes imposed on such individual under Chapter 42 of the Code. Further, no payment shall be made under this Article if such payment would constitute an act of self-dealing or a taxable expenditure, as defined in Section 4941(d) and 4945(d), respectively, of the Code.

If any part of this Article shall be found in any action, suit, or proceeding to be invalid or ineffective, the validity and the effectiveness of the remaining parts shall not be affected.

Section 6.07 Electronic Signatures. Wherever a written instrument is required to be executed hereunder, an electronic signature, to the extent permitted by applicable law, shall be deemed to be a written signature

Section 6.08 Delivery of Instruments to the Administrator. All documents or other instruments required to be delivered to the Administrator by accessing the Administrator's system shall be delivered by accessing the website located at www foundationsource.com or such other website as the Administrator may hereafter designate.

All documents or other instruments required to be delivered to the Administrator via the United States Postal Service hereunder shall be sent to the Administrator's mailing address listed on the website located at www.foundationsource.com or on such other website as the Administrator may hereafter designate.

Section 5 09 References to the Administrator. Any reference to the Administrator herein shall refer to Foundation Source Philanthropic Services Inc., a Delaware corporation, or any successor thereto
