The Simon Bolívar Foundation (SBF) exists primarily to give the gift of hope to those who are critically ill and unable to pay for treatment. To do this, the Foundation provides access to specialized medical treatment and financial assistance to these individuals by relieving the burden of excessive medical costs for patients, and their families, located in various countries. Specialized treatments are provided in collaboration with our worldwide network of hospitals and medical institutions. SBF's assistance also includes travel, housing, living expenses, medical devices, prescriptions and funeral arrangements (when needed). SBF also meets the needs of qualifying individuals in severely distressing situations. In addition to its other charitable programs, in 2016 SBF created a program to donate medical equipment, supplies and services to hospitals for the provision of healthcare to those in need. During 2017, 192 patients were provided assistance. Approximately 60 – 70 CITGO employees volunteer their time to the SBF in providing services such as operational, accounting, tax, legal, procurement, audit and other services. A number of employees of CITGO's affiliates, including PDVSA, also volunteer their time to the SBF's medical programs and disaster relief efforts.
