The Foundation's "Book Initiative" program purchases and gives books, CDs and DVDs of Buddhist teachings and meditation instruction by its founder, Pema Chodron, to under-served populations. During 2017 it gave about 1,100 books, CDs and DVDs to a variety of groups and individuals around the world. About 2,000 individuals have benefited. Some of the agencies that have benefited are cancer recovery groups, prison support groups, addiction recovery groups, AIDS clinics, and homeless shelters. It has been found that the Buddhist teachings can be especially helpful to people experiencing difficult challenges in their lives.

26 additional program service activities include contracts for publishing of books, CDs, and DVDs on meditation; live seminars on Buddhist meditation; support for several nunneries, monasteries, schools, and medical clinics in the Himalayas, grants for community services such as prison meditation and yoga projects, grants for several American monastics to attend various trainings and retreat programs, and grants for translation and dissemination of Buddhist teachings. Of the total grants made in 2017, 50% went to general Buddhist programs, 41% to monastic programs, 8% to various service programs, and 1% to individual scholarship grants.
