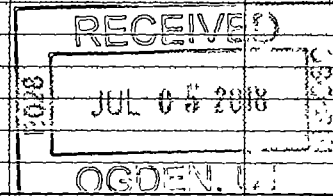

TERMINATION

WHEREAS, the Robert L. Turner Charitable Trust, a charitable trust governed by New York law, was established December 15, 2004 by an instrument created by Robert L. Turner as Grantor and Trustee (the "Trust");

WHEREAS, Robert L. Turner is the sole current trustee of the Trust;


WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of subparagraph A of Article XII of the Trust, "[t]he Grantor's intention is that this Trust shall continue in perpetuity, provided, however, that Trust shall continue for so long as the Trustee, or if incorporated the Boards of Directors of the corporation shall determine;"

WHEREAS, subparagraph B of Article XII provides that "[u]pon any termination of the Trust under the preceding subparagraph A or for any other reason in the event of dissolution, all of the remaining assets and property of the Trust shall, after payment of necessary expenses thereof, be distributed to such organizations as shall qualify under Code Section 501(c)(3), as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Trustee has decided to terminate the Trust and distribute the Trust's remaining principal and income to the American Gift Fund FBO RLT Foundation, a public charity entitled to exemption from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, which is described in Section 170(b)(1)(A) of the Code (other than in Sections 170(b)(1)(A)(vii) and (viii)) and has been in existence and so described for a continuous period of at least 60 calendar months immediately preceding the date hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned Trustee, in the exercise of his discretion, hereby terminates the Trust and distributes the Trust's remaining principal and income to American Gift Fund FBO RLT Foundation.
