In 2017, around 20,925 toys and clothing items and 132,200 pounds of food were contributed in exchange for raffle tickets. The toys and clothing items are valued at \$20 a piece and the food is valued at \$1.60 a pound. The toys, clothing and food are then donated to selected public charities that distribute the items to needy and military families.
1b	The golf tournament is held at the beginning of "Operation Santa Claus" and provides funds that are donated to selected public charities. In 2017, through sponsorships and entry fees, the golf tournament's net revenue was \$88,876 (Gross revenue of \$139,240, less direct costs of \$50,364).
