	missions to the Grande Anse Department of Haiti and treated approximately 2,700 patients. Our volunteer doctors and nurses
	donated over 1,800 hours seeing patients. The volunteers paid all of their travel costs to and from the city of Jeremie. Our
	volunteers diagnosed each patient and provided them with medications to treat their conditions. We also made over 150 referrals for
	people with serious or chronic conditions to other providers and paid all of the expenses for their care, including a small travel
	stipend based on their distance from the provider Of those over 150 referrals, 47 people were referred to Port-au-Prince or other
	major location for serious conditions that could not be treated in the Jeremie area. We provided funds to these individuals so they
	could travel and pay for their medical care

	Health and Education for Haiti's second major program area is education. During 2017, we provided several grants that enabled
	us to assist over 800 students to attend primary or secondary school Grants totaled \$200 to assist an individual student with
	tuition payments. This student has special needs identified through our medical missions. These funds were paid to the parents of
	the special needs child upon inspection of the bill from the special needs school and a prognosis from the school. In addition, Health
	and Education for Haiti also subsidizes teacher salaries to reduce the overall cost of schooling to make it less expensive for all.
	Grants of \$31,100 were paid directly to two schools to cover significant portions of teacher salaries. Over 800 students attend these
	two schools Heart of Jesus School (Grades 1-6, over 650 students), and College Notre Dame (Grades 7-12, over 200 students)
	benefited from these grants with significantly reduced education costs College Notre Dame is the only secondary school within a 15
	radius, so it is an enabler for these students who otherwise wouldn't attend secondary school. Additionally grants of \$5,613 were
	awarded to support the college education of 5 students in the Leon region recommended by the Executive Director of the Heart of
	Jesus School and Orphanage as an exceptional student with no other means to obtain the funding to attend University
