Part 1, Line 2 & 3 As part of our Monitor/Evaluation Program, we visit school sites 2-3 times per year with Volunteers to evaluate the need
for classrooms, support for disadvantaged students so they are able to go to school, and support to ensure that students
are receiving a quality education. Direct observations of existing and in-process projects are made to ensure that goals
and objectives for the expansion of quality educational opportunities in Niger are being met. Initially, our partner
organizations request funds or support for a project with specific goals and objectives. In the case of capital projects,
local Nigerien leaders must meet certain criteria before support is mobilized and transferred. We create, discuss and
sign a Memorandum of Understanding for the construction of each school building and the development of each school
site, which includes the number and amounts of funds that will be transferred, the monitoring and evaluation process
and clear expectations and responsibilities for our organizations. We transfer the funds to the partner Ecobank accounts
as directed in the memorandum of understanding. The process is similar for the Student Sponsorship Program. School
boards and directors send us the names and photos of students who meet certain criteria, which is primarily dependent
on the family's inability to pay the school fees. During our visits to Niger, we take updated photos of each student in the
program Additionally, each sponsored student makes an art project and/or writes a letter to their sponsor. In addition
to visiting the school sites 2-3 times per a year, we communicate by phone and email weekly with our partners, who
send us notice of receipt of funds, photos of projects and programs and reports. We maintain complete and accurate
records documenting the process and results of our programs and projects. Currently, our partners include the
Evangelical Church of Niger, the Deaf School/Association in Niamey, the Salama School in Tahoua, the Hamsa School for
Girls in Tahoua, the Maradi Handicap Association and RN-Niger
