VOLUNTEERS TEACH ENGLISH TO MOTHERS AND OLDER CHILDREN ON A WEEKLY BASIS AND TUTOR SCHOOL CHILDREN. HOLIDAY GIFTS HAVE BEEN PROVIDED FOR RELIGIOUS HOLIDAYS SUCH AS CHRISTMAS AND EID. IN 2017, THE FOUNDATION ASSISTED NINETY FAMILIES IN THESE WAYS.
