Education: We believe education is vital to social and economic development because it gives people in our communities the knowledge and skills they need to achieve employment and economic security in our rapidly changing, global economy. To help keep our communities and our business competitive and prosperous, we support formal educational opportunities for students of all ages including K-12 education, higher education, business-education partnerships, and other local needs. Organizations that meet the Foundation's eligibility requirements will be permitted to register and complete the Foundation's grant application.

#### Response

The Ball Foundation board of directors meets quarterly. Organizations that pass the eligibility review and complete online applications can expect a response within approximately 90 days, depending on the board meeting cycle.
