THE FOUNDATION PROVIDES INFORMATION CONCERNING THE SCHOLARSHIPS TO HIGH SCHOOL GUIDANCE COUNSELORS, PUBLIC LIBRARIES, SOCIAL SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS, YOUTH GROUPS, AND MEDIA OUTLETS IN THE SERVICE AREA.

SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AWARDED PRIMARILY BASED ON FINANCIAL NEED, WITH CONSIDERATION ALSO GIVEN TO ACADEMIC POTENTIAL, CITIZENSHIP, AND COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT. APPLICANTS SHOULD HAVE A MINIMUM 2.5 GPA. APPLICANTS MAY REAPPLY FOR UP TO A MAXIMUM OF FIVE ACADEMIC YEARS. THE FOUNDATION AWARDS A SMALL NUMBER OF GRADUATE SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS; ONLY STUDENTS WHO HAVE RECEIVED THE AMERICAN SAVINGS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP AS UNDERGRADUATES ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY. PRIORITY IS GIVEN TO STUDENTS PURSUING A MASTER'S DEGREE IN EDUCATION OR SOCIAL SERVICE, AND WHO ARE ATTENDING GRADUATE SCHOOL IN THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT. THE FOUNDATION ALSO HAS A "SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIPS" PROGRAM WHICH ACCEPTS APPLICATIONS FROM STUDENTS WHO DID NOT MEET THE GPA REQUIREMENT TO APPLY FOR THE GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP. THESE APPLICANTS MUST HAVE COMPLETED A HIGH QUALITY COLLEGE PREPARATION PROGRAM (FOR EXAMPLE, CONNCAP AT CCSU) OR OTHERWISE DEMONSTRATE THAT THEY ARE PREPARED TO BE SUCCESSFUL IN COLLEGE OR CAREER TRAINING. AT THE DISCRETION OF THE FOUNDATION, THESE
