Before you apply

The Nationwide Foundation only accepts funding applications through this website. The next grant application window will open in mid-May 2018. Before you apply, see if your request meets our funding guidelines. Also, keep in mind that the following will not be considered:

- Multiple grant proposals from one organization
- Incomplete applications
- Applications not submitted through the foundation's online application program
- Applications received after the deadline
- Videos, albums or binders (cannot be returned)

Required documentation

If your organization meets our funding criteria, please have the following required information available before you begin your application to easily complete your application and not risk losing information.

- Your organization's charitable tax ID number/EIN
- List of funders (PDF) from whom you have submitted a request and the status of each request (approved, pending or to be submitted)
- W9 (PDF)
- IRS 501(c)(3) Letter of Determination
- Operating budget
- Names and addresses of your board of directors
- Project/program budget if you're submitting for a program, project or capital request
- Your organization's most recent audited financial statement

Applying for a grant

The grant application deadline for 2018 funding has passed. The next grant application window will open in mid-May 2018 and run through Sept. 1, 2018.

After you apply

What we don't fund

We don't fund the following:

Organizations that are not tax exempt under paragraph 551(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code

Organizations that, in their constitution, discriminate against a person or group on the basis of race, color, age, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, ethnicity, disability, genetic information, religion, national origin, ancestry, veteran status, marital status or any other characteristic protected by law

Veterans, labor, religious or fraternal groups (except when these groups provide needed services to the community at large)

Groups or organizations that will re-grant the foundation's gifts to other organizations or individuals (except United Way)

Public or private primary or secondary schools

Athletic events or teams, bands and choirs

Individuals for any purpose

Lobbying activities

Fund-raising events such as walk-a-thons, telethons, and sponsorships

Cost-reduction or retirement campaigns

Endowment campaigns

Requests to support travel

Other organizations we don't fund

As a general policy, because the foundation matches our associates' United Way contributions dollar for dollar, organizations that receive support from United Way are ineligible to receive general operating support. But they may be considered for project and capital grants.

I didn't pass the eligibility quiz. Why not?

The quiz questions are designed to make sure that a request fits the National Foundation's funding guidelines. If you received a message that your proposal doesn't meet the funding guidelines, the foundation regrets that we won't be able to provide support. If you have questions about our funding guidelines, please email us.

If Sept. 1 falls on a weekend or holiday, does the deadline change?

No, the deadline is Sept. 1 at 11:59 p.m. EDT regardless of when it falls.

Why can't my application be found once I've logged into my account?

If your application is not found, it's most likely that the application wasn't saved properly and you'll need to start a new application.

I forgot my password. What do I do?

Go to the grant application page and click "Continue a saved application." On the login page, click "Forgot your password?" Click here: "We'll email your password to the email address you entered at the time you submitted or saved the application."

I'm trying to submit my application, but I keep getting a message saying that an attachment is missing.

Make sure that each "title of the document" matches up with each corresponding "file name" document. For example, if you've saved all of your documents under the "List Board of Directors" title, the system won't recognize that you've attached all of the required documents.

Someone who left our organization previously saved an application. How can I access it?

Unfortunately, you'll need to set up a new account under your email address. We can retrieve applications that have been submitted, but not those that were saved without being submitted. Email us if you need a copy of a previously submitted application.

I'm having technical issues. Where can I get help?
