As detailed in this organization's Form 1023, Application for Recognition of Exemption, this entity is the S. Mark Taper Foundation, a newly formed charitable trust (EIN 32-0516588). Hereafter, for purposes of these Exhibits, this entity will be referred to as the "New Taper Foundation." The New Taper Foundation received tax exempt status under the Internal Revenue Code pursuant to a determination letter dated June 13, 2017 and tax exempt status under the California Revenue and Taxation Code pursuant to a letter dated January 1, 2018 with an effective date of June 13, 2017. The New Taper Foundation was formed by an existing California nonprofit public benefit corporation also called the S. Mark Taper Foundation (the "Old Taper Foundation"). The Old Taper Foundation was incorporated in March 1989 and received a determination letter from the I.R.S. in March 1990 granting it tax-exempt status as a Section 501(c)(3) private foundation. The EIN of the Old Taper Foundation is 95-4245076.

The New Taper Foundation did not engage in any activities during 2017. For purposes of establishing bank accounts in the name of the New Taper Foundation, the Old Taper Foundation made a transfer of \$2,000 in assets (cash).

The Board of Directors of the Old Taper Foundation determined that it is in the best interests of the Old Taper Foundation for it to convert from a California nonprofit public benefit corporation to a charitable trust. Inorder to effectuate this conversion, the Old Taper Foundation will transfer all of its tax attributes, assets, and liabilities to the New Taper Foundation, effective January 1, 2018 with the New Taper Foundation being the entity that will continue in existence. Beginning January 1, 2018, all of the Old Taper Foundation's activities will thereafter be undertaken by the New Taper Foundation and the Board of Directors will begin the process of terminating the Old Taper Foundation.

Pursuant to Internal Revenue Code (IRC) §4940(e)(6), beginning January 1, 2018, the experience of the Old Taper Foundation will be applied to all calculations required under IRC §4940(e)(1)-(5) for the New Taper Foundation.
