BECAUSE OF THE LACK OF CONTROL, THE VALUE OF THIS STOCK HAS BEEN REDUCED BY 10%, OR \$4,708,222. THE REDUCTION IS APPROPRIATE FOR PURPOSES OF SECTION 4942 BECAUSE THE FOUNDATION'S MINIMUM INVESTMENT RETURN IS BASED ON THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF ALL ASSETS, AND THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE STOCK IN A CLOSELY-HELD CORPORATION IS IMPAIRED BY VIRTUE OF ITS NOT BEING A CONTROLLING INTEREST.
