The foundation is organized and operated to make distributions for charitable and other exempt purposes. The foundation exists primarily to make grants to other charitable Section 501(c)(3) organizations. The foundation also has a program by which it makes payments directly to or for the benefit of disadvantaged individuals in the community who are suffering financial hardship. Such individuals commonly are referred to the foundation by a church or other charitable organization in the community. The payments under this program are to provide food, shelter and living expenses or to cover certain identifiable expenses that the individual is not otherwise capable of paying. Payments are not made for study, travel or similar purposes within the meaning of Section 4945(D)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

The foundation normally makes only small distributions (not totaling more than \$5,000) pursuant to this program. However, this limit may be exceeded in cases where the foundation deems it appropriate. In some case, a payment may be made directly to a third party provider and earmarked for the individual's benefit. Under no circumstances does an individual having a family relationship with any foundation director, officer or contributor receive any payment (directly or indirectly) under this program. The foundation maintains records of expenditures made under this program in a manner consistent with the principles outlined in Revenue Ruling 56-304
