The Company supports an organization (North Iowa Ag In The Classroom) that provides elementary curriculum services in 9 counties which includes 30 local area schools. Four in-county events were also sponsored for ag in the classroom events along with scholarships awarded to local high school graduates attending college with an emphasis in the ag sector.

AGRICULTURAL PROMOTION The Company promoted agriculture to the general public and its members in several ways during the year. An annual appreciation picnic was hosted for the Company's 1,687 members. The Company also works closely with the Chamber Ag Committee organizing agricultural tours.
