We currently are providing the following services:

- Monthly Community Hearing Clinic: Reduced fee, sliding scale hearing care services for individuals with incomes up to 250% of Federal Poverty Level
- Hearing Aid Donation Box Program: Collecting gently used hearing aids that can be reprogrammed for low-income individuals.
- Hearing screening at local preschool and day care facilities: Serving large percentages of low-income families.
- Loaner Program for Cancer & Hospice Patients: Partnership with Cancer Services and Heartland Home Healthcare to provide hearing aids for cancer patients and hospice patients who have lost hearing.
- Satellite Program: In response to requests from audiology practices in other communities wishing to begin their own not-for-profit program in their community, HearCare Connection is now providing administrative support and guidance to new programs in Toledo, Ohio and Sarasota, Florida. Each satellite is responsible for raising funds to support their own program.
- "Circle of Giving": We are not a free clinic. Fees for services are based on a sliding scale according to family size and income so that hearing aids are affordable for patients while also requiring them to make a personal investment in their own healthcare. In addition, we require patients to complete a set number of volunteer service hours at a not-for-profit agency within our community to earn "sweat equity" for their hearing aids. Because we rely on the community's support to operate our program, our patients give back to the community that has made it possible for them to receive care.

David, age 71, has a plan after he receives his hearing aids from GiveHear: "I'm ready to go make some conversations with a bunch of people." Many individuals with

hearing loss experience social isolation, whether they realize it or not. It might begin with avoiding large parties or gatherings and trickle down to canceling on smaller, intimate affairs. For those with hearing loss, large groups, noisy venues, and dark environments can make it even more difficult to hear, engage in conversation and contribute to social situations. In certain conditions, including age, illness and genetics may contribute to hearing loss. It is estimated that 36 million Americans struggle to connect to others due to poor hearing. Approximately 1 in 5 people has some degree of hearing loss. HearCare Connection (dba GiveHear) is working to provide the reconnection necessary for individuals to fully engage in the world around them.

When a person is affected by hearing loss, more than just their social relationships are at risk. Hearing loss can have a very real and negative impact on an adult's ability to achieve economic stability and on children's development. Adults with hearing loss have a much higher unemployment rate. Among those who are employed, a higher percentage of people with hearing loss are in the lower grades of employment, some up to 25% lower, compared to the general workforce (The Hearing Journal). Early detection and intervention are crucial to minimizing the impact of hearing loss on a child's development and educational achievements. In infants and young children, early identification and management through early hearing screening programs can improve the linguistic and educational outcomes for the child.

Hearing aids are a simple and effective tool to counteract the negative impact of hearing loss. They are designed to help with localizing the direction of sound, improve listening in noisy situations, and can provide better overall hearing. However according to the American Speech Language Hearing Association (ASHA), less than 25% of all people who could benefit from hearing actually get them. The cost and the lack of availability for servicing and maintaining hearing aids keeps people from getting the help they need. The average cost of a pair of hearing aids is

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\$3,000-\$6,000 and most insurance does not cover hearing aids.

These issues are at the heart of the services our organization provides to the communities we serve. Our focus on hearing healthcare for under-insured and low-income individuals allows individuals to afford hearing aids, get the hearing testing they need, and maintain quality hearing healthcare with a licensed audiologist. We are standing in the gap saying "no" to a lesser quality of life for the 10,000 individuals living in poverty and who are affected by hearing loss.

HearCare Connection (dba GiveHear) is a nonprofit hearing center that provides quality and affordable hearing healthcare for low-income adults (below 250% of the federal poverty level) and under-served children. We primarily operate in Northeast Indiana with satellite offices in Toledo, Ohio and Sarasota, Florida. Our services benefit all ages from infants to the elderly. The demographic breakdown is 25% Youth (under 18), 35% Adults (18-63) and 40% Seniors (over 64).

By treating hearing loss in low-income patients, we are addressing a physical need which can also impact the individual emotionally, spiritually, and economically. Our program has the potential to create a brighter future for children and a sense of independence for adults. Our clients benefit immediately from our services through improvement in their ability to hear environmental and speech sounds. Long-term goals for children are improvement in speech and language skills, and school grades, and increased participation in social activities. Long-term goals for adults are increased income potential, social interaction with peers, civic engagement, and quality of life and decreased feelings of isolation and depression.

Our fees are based on a sliding scale for family size and income. This ensures that hearing aids are affordable for patients while also requiring them to make a personal investment in their own healthcare. In addition to our nominal fees, we require our patients to complete a set number of volunteer service hours at a not-for-profit agency within our community to earn "sweat equity" for their hearing

aids. We call this our "Circle of Giving" model. Because our fees are so low, they do not cover the full costs to operate our program and we rely on the support of the community in the form of donations, fundraisers, and grants to fill in the gap. In turn, we require patients to complete volunteer service hours in the community in addition to their fee schedule for their hearing aids to complete our "Circle". We receive funds from the community to provide services to our patients and our patients return "sweat equity" back to the community. Since 2012, our patients have volunteered over 7,000 hours of service. Many of our patients find their volunteer experience so rewarding they continue to volunteer after their mandatory hours are completed.

With improved capacity to hear, clients are better able to interact with those around them and report feeling happier, more engaged, and more connected.

"Hearing aids helped me connect with church members." "I can hear my daughter now and am having fun going out to eat with her." Kenneth, age 70

"School is easy now because I know what I have to do for homework." Olivia, age 8 Our sliding fee scale builds on clients' self-sufficiency. Instead of providing our services completely free, we charge clients fees based on their household income and ability to pay. By doing this, clients are invested in their own health care and retain a sense of dignity and self-sufficiency. At the same time, we are able to ensure clients receive the hearing healthcare they need, regardless of their financial situation.

Our "Circle of Giving" model also helps empower individuals and improve self-sufficiency by requiring clients to give back the community by volunteering with other not-for-profit agencies. For many, volunteering is a new experience. Many
