	FARMERS MARKET MANAGEMENT: In 2017, ALG managed two very different types of farmers markets in the Augusta, GA, area.
	1) THE ALG ON-LINE FARMERS MARKET is the first, direct farm-to-consumer farmers market in the Augusta area, with pick-up
	locations in two counties. This market is a service to local farmers in that it significantly streamlines the market process for more
	effective use of time and resources for farmers. In 2017, the on-line farmers market included about 40 vendors, many of them new
	to farming and/or farmers markets. As such, Augusta Locally Grown also provides a service to new farmers, helping them learn
	and work within the county, state and federal guidelines for food safety and organic practices. This market runs year-round.
	2) THE VEGGIE PARK FARMERS MARKET is a traditional, direct farm-to-consumer market in a low-income inner-city neighborhood
	of Augusta called Harrisburg. It is the only market in Augusta that accepts and doubles EBT/SNAP, in partnership with Wholesome
	Wave Georgia. This farmers market has a significant educational component, including free cooking demos for adults, free childrens
	health food education, free gardening advice from Georgia Master Gardener volunteers and free transportation from Good Neighbor
	Ministries. The market is run by community members from the neighborhood, along with volunteer students from the Medical College
	of Georgia and the Augusta University Dietetic program. The market runs April-October.
