	to promote a positive and healthy lifestyle; and solidify the gains accomplished in treatment. The design of the project is to find safe and sober supportive housing in the community and hire qualified Sober Coaches to provide housing support services to deaf adults

	Hearing Individuals (MCDPDHHI). \$126,000 annual fiscal year grant is used for facility, equipment, and staffing costs. Sober Coaches

Client Incentives are used to encourage sobriety and meeting program objectives. Assistance includes food, personal needs, social activities, and gift cards. Gift cards are

priced at no more than \$20 each and cannot be used for purchasing alcohol, tobacco, or licit or illicit drugs, including energy drinks. Client Emergency Funds are used for clients who

re transitioning from temporary living situations or shelters into more permanent housing. That includes personal needs and food supplies, additional furniture for their apartment.
