ALL FUNDS GIVEN TO THE DIRECTOR, THE MAINTENANCE CONSTRUCTION MAN, OR OTHER STAFF MEMBERS OTHER THAN THE STAFF ADMINISTRATOR ARE MONITORED BY THE STAFF ADMINISTRATOR: YAHAIRA MEETS REGULARLY WITH THOSE STAFF MEMBERS AND GETS RECEIPTS FOR ALL MONEY SPENT AND ANY RETURNED MONEY THAT WAS OVER OR MAKES PAYMENT FOR ANY LACK BECAUSE PRICES WERE BIGGER THAN ESTIMATED. SINCE YAHAIRA IS IN CHARGE OF PAYROLL AND PAYING THE UTILITIES, THE INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR, APRIL HAVLIN, GIVES THE FUNDING FOR ALL ITEMS SHE WILL PAY DIRECTLY TO YAHAIRA. THIS IS NECESSARY BECAUSE THE RECEIPTS FROM HONDURAS ARE IN LEMPIRAS, BUT THEY ARE ENTERED INTO QUICKBOOKS IN DOLLARS.

WE HAVE A VOLUNTEER PROFESSIONAL ACCOUNTANT IN HONDURAS WHO OVERSEES THE PROCESS AND TURNS IN THE NECESSARY FINANCIAL STATEMENT TO THE HONDURAN GOVERNMENT EACH YEAR.

THE PROGRAM IN BOLIVIA IS MUCH SMALLER. THROUGH THE BAKERY THAT HOUSE & OF HOPE INTERNATIONAL HELPED THEM TO SET UP, THEY GENERATE A LOT OF THEIR OWN

FUNDING. ALSO, THE CHURCH THAT THEY ARE UNDER THE UMBRELLA OF, PROVIDES A LOT OF DONATIONS IN KIND FOR THE WOMEN AND CHILDREN WHO LIVE IN A RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM AND SOME INGREDIENTS FOR THE BAKING PROGRAM. HOUSE OF HOPE INTERNATIONAL WORKS ALONGSIDE THEM. FROM APRIL 2014 UNTIL JULY OF 2020 WHEN SHE PASSED AWAY, NELVY, THE NATIONAL DIRECTOR FOR BOLIVIA, MOSTLY HANDLED THE FUNDS DONATED TO HOUSE OF HOPE. NELVY HANDLED ALL THE FUNDS FOR DAY-TO-DAY RUNNING OF THE PROGRAM AND HELPING THE INDIVIDUAL WOMEN AND CHILDREN. NELVY WAS A VOLUNTEER.

HOUSE OF HOPE BOLIVIA WOULD GIVE HOUSE OF HOPE INTERNATIONAL A RECEIPT FOR ANY MONEY GIVEN. MONEY GIVEN FOR EACH PURPOSE WAS WITH A SEPARATE CASH RECEIPT. HOUSE OF HOPE INTERNATIONAL DID NOT BECOME INVOLVED IN RECORDING RECEIPTS IN BOLIVIANO'S IN QUICKBOOKS. ALL MONEY GIVEN TO HOUSE OF HOPE BOLIVIA THROUGH THE CHURCH WAS HANDLED WITH ONE RECEIPT FOR EACH DISPERSAL. NELVY AND THE BOLIVIANS FILED ALL THEIR RECEIPTS. WHEN APRIL HAVLIN, THE INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR WOULD VISIT BOLIVIA, SHE WOULD LOOK OVER ALL THE RECEIPTS BUT NOT ENTER THEM INDIVIDUALLY INTO QUICKBOOKS. THESE WERE USUALLY SMALL AMOUNTS AND DID NOT ADD TO A CONSIDERABLE SUM OVERTIME. THEY WERE USED MOSTLY FOR COSTS FOR THE EVANGELISTIC EVENTS, MEDICAL EXPENSES AND ON OCCASION SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR CHILDREN AND TO PAY THE UTILITIES FOR THE HOUSE OF HOPE BUILDING.
