The scholarships will be publicized through the Fairfield Community High School, its staff, teachers and guidance office counselors. Applications will be available at the Fairfield Community High School. Students should apply through his/her high school counseling office or the Fairfield National Bank trust department.

The number and amount of the scholarships awarded annually will be determined by the advisory committee and be disbursed in one increment on or about September 1.

Student must maintain a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale and remain a full-time student to receive subsequent awards.

Student must prove enrollment as a full-time student prior to receipt of initial scholarship funds. Prior to subsequent disbursements, the recipient must provide a copy of transcript documenting enrollment and grade point average which meets scholarship standards.

The recipients must provide supporting documentation such as invoices for tuition, books or room and board to prove scholarship funds were used as intended. If funds are determined to be used for purposes other than intended, recipient will be pursued by whatever lawful means necessary to recover scholarship funds.
