Syndrome by providing family support, raising awareness, and supporting research and education.
The highlight of 2017 for this organization was the hosting of the 2017 Mowat-Wilson Syndrome Foundaton International Family Conference
in Washington, DC June 30-July 2, 2017 for the persons and their families affected by Mowat-Wilson Syndrome. Over 250 people attended

and vidoes of lectures and workshops were posted on our website, for those families that could not attend the conference. The conference
was successful beyond our expectations!!!
MWSF continues to participate in partnership with Genetic Alliance in maintaining the MWSF PEER Patient Registry. There are three surveys
that are available for families to complete. More surveys on specific medical topics on Mowat-Wilson Syndrome to be uploaded in 2018.
The purpose of this patient registry is collect information related to this rare genetic syndrome to be available for researchers.
MWSF also participates in Rare Disease Day by attending state events and providing e-cards for families to post of social media. The MWSF
