

	In 2017, EAGLE US continued its support to EAGLE's partner in Uganda, the Natural Resource Conservation Network (NRCN).
	NRCN is a network of professionals utilizing their training to ensure timely investigations, prosecutions and the reporting of wildlife
	crime in Uganda. Funds were used in the building and support of a wildlife law enforcement network, which includes the Uganda
	Wildlife Authority, judiciary, Directorate of Public Prosecutions, police and other NGOs.

	In 2017, EAGLE US continued its support to EAGLE's partner in Gabon, AALF. AALF organized 367 investigations of illegal
	wildlife trade in the 9 provinces of Gabon and working with law enforcement facilitated arrests in 8 of the provinces (96 persons
	arrested). Sixty nine wildlife smugglers were sentenced with an average jail sentence of 143 days. Work continued to strengthen
	weak maximum sentencing laws and a new forest/wildlife law was finalized.

	In 2017, EAGLE assisted wildlife conservation efforts in Cameroon through its partner, LAGA (The Last Great Ape Organization).
	A total of 284 investigation missions were carried out in 8 regions. Forty one new cases were brought to court and thirty seven

Schedule F, Part I, Line 2 - EAGLE-US accomplishes it's charitable purposes by making grants to nonprofit organizations working in key
African countries to support programs that are designed to increase wildlife law enforcement effectiveness, produce effective deterrents
against wildlife crime, and combat the illegal wildlife trade so detrimental to the survival of elephants, apes, and other threatened species.
The projects we fund follow a particular proven method (the "EAGLE model"), generally consisting of the following elements: Investigations,
including scienting, hiring and training undercover investigators to successfully identify and infiltrate large-scale, illegal wildlife trafficking
operations in order to develop concrete evidence that can be used to bring them to justice in accordance with national and international laws
in force; Operations, including providing assistance to national law enforcement with in bringing about arrest and supervising law
enforcement operation in the field to guard against corruptions, such as bribery and the peddling; Legal assistance, including helping
government lawyers bring about the prosecution of wildlife offenses and monitoring the legal process at every step (arraignment, trial,
sentencing, and incarceration) in order to intercept and combat corruption attempts, and Media, including preparing and distributing press
releases and encouraging in-country TV news, radio news and the written press to publicize the operational and legal successes, thereby
educating the public on the illegality of wildlife poaching and trafficking, demonstrating that the laws are actively enforced, and increasing
amplifying the deterrent effect of the legal successes. In 2017, we awarded grants to a number of organizations that operate projects that
follow the EAGLE model. Collectively, the organizations operating funded projects, and the overall program itself, is called the EAGLE

prior programmatic history, and experience of the potential grantee and its managers. We only make a grant to an organization when we are
satisfied that the grantee intends to usc and is capable of using the funds in the manner required, in close adherence to the procedures and
policies we establish, and that sufficient political stability exists within the country for the funded project to be successful. EAGLE-US
receives and maintains reports from each grantee at least annually on the use of grant funds, the grantee's compliance with the terms of the
written grant statement, and the progress made by the grantee toward achieving the purpose for which each grant is made.
