Part XIII (990-PF) - Undistributed Income

In 2018, The Spofford Foundation, Inc. (the "Foundation") discovered that on its Form 990-PF for taxable year ending December 31, 2016, Parts X and XI were not recorded properly and the return overstated the amount of excess grant carryover made during the year due to an error made by the Foundation's former tax preparer. The Foundation's new tax preparer discovered these errors while preparing Form 990-PF for taxable year ending December 31, 2017.

The Foundation would not have been subject to an underdistribution penalty under §4942 for the year 2017 had the average value of the assets been properly recorded in Part X or had the erroneous additional excess grant carryover not been claimed on the 2016 Form 990-PF. Therefore, the Foundation has chosen not to amend Form 990-PF for taxable year ending December 31, 2016. Instead, the Foundation has adjusted the amounts reported in Parts V and XIII of Form 990-PF for year ending December 31, 2017 to reflect the correct balances.
