Repatriating American films unavailable in the U.S. The NFPF continued working on the partnership with the EYE Filmmuseum Netherlands to preserve and make available more than 50 American films that have been unseen for decades. Titles preserved include the feature-length documentary Alaskan Adventures (1922), chronicling a year-long trip across Alaska; Almost a Widow (1917), an early role for Betty Compson; and the industrial Glimpse of the Remington Factory (ca. 1926), following the construction of a typewriter. Films from this effort will be available for streaming at www.filmpreservation.org. The NFPF is commissioning music and scholarly essays for the online presentation of the fiction films.

The NFPF also provided a grant to the San Francisco Silent Film Festival to preserve Soft Shoes (1925), which was discovered at the National Film Archive of the Czech Republic.
