During 2017, the Council made grants of cash to the Ellicott City 50+ Center Petty Cash Fund for some programs and expenses. In August 2017, the Council started paying for programs directly by checks from the Council bank account. For this reason and because the coffee donations now go directly to the Nutritionist in charge of the Lunch Program instead of into the Center Petty Cash Fund, the Ellicott City 50+ Center Petty Cash Fund was closed at the end of 2017.

When the Council wishes to purchase items from outside sources for the Center, the Center Director can charge the purchase on her Howard County charge card, and the Council will reimburse the cost by sending a check to the Director of Finance, Howard County. The Center is owned and operated by Howard County government. The Council owns no property but uses the property of the Center. The Council has no liabilities. All assets of the Council are contained in the Council checking account, and all assets are designated for support of the Ellicott City 50+ Center.
